2008 CCEA State Conference slated for Los Angeles

The theme for the 2008 CCEA state conference is “Lights, Camera, Action, Education!” The conference will be held on April 25, 26, and 27, 2008 at the Sheraton Gateway Hotel in Los Angeles adjacent to LAX. 3 full days of educational and social activities are planned. There will be over 50 different workshops from which to choose. We plan to have over 50 exhibitors and vendors presenting the best in educational products. There will be trips to visit local continuation schools and museums. We will be honoring the best of our own with our Teacher of the Year Award, and the Classified, Administrators, and Support employees of the year, The recipients of the 2008 Model School Distinctions and the Exemplary programs will be introduced and honored.

As the theme for the conference is entertainment related, the artistic achievements of our continuation students will be spotlighted. There will be an exhibit of student visual art, live student performances of music and dance, and the screening of student video productions. We will also award scholarships to the winners of our student essay contest.
